

# Portugal

## *Lisboa y Oporto*



### **Day 1 • Lisbon**

Arrival at Lisbon Airport. Assistance and transfer to Hotel Mundial 4 \* or similar, located in the historical center of the Portuguese capital city, very close on foot of the most cosmopolitan and commerce filled streets. Accommodation.

### **Day 2 • Lisbon**

Buffet breakfast at the Hotel. Departure for Half-Day Tour of the city of Lisbon, one of the most beautiful cities in Europe. **Belém**: historic district, **Belém Tower**: ex-libris of Lisbon and jewel of Manueline art. **Padrão dos Descobrimentos**: modern monument dedicated to the Portuguese discoveries. **Mosteiro Jerónimos**: is the greatest example of Manueline art. Visit the Church. Closed on Mondays. **Coach Museum**: the best collection of old coaches and carriages in Europe. Closed Mondays (alternative visit to **Palacio da Ajuda**). **Oporto wine** tasting. **Alfama**: the oldest and most picturesque neighborhood in Lisbon. Walk the neighborhood on foot. **Praça do Comércio**: is the largest and most beautiful square of Lisbon. **Baixa-Rossio**: Center of the city. **Avenida da Liberdade** and **Marques de Pombal**. Return to the Hotel. Free Afternoon.

### **Day 3 • Lisbon / Sintra / Cabo de Roca / Cascais / Estoril / Lisbon**

Buffet breakfast at the Hotel and departure to Full Day Tour with Lunch to **Sintra**: historic center of the town, Unesco World Heritage since 1995. Free time. **National Palace**: former hunting residence for the Portuguese Royal Family in the 15th century. Visit. **Cabo da Roca**: Most western point of the European continent. ( From the 31st of October to the 1st of March, replaced by stop at **Boca do Inferno** (Hell's Mouth)). **Cascais**: Fishing harbor and touristic center. Former summer residence for the Portuguese Royal Family. **Estoril**: Panoramic of the casino and its gardens. Return to Lisbon and to the Hotel.

### **Day 4 • Lisbon / Óbidos / Nazaré / Batalha / Fátima / Lisbon**

Buffet breakfast at the Hotel and beginning of our Full-Day Tour with Lunch to **Óbidos**: Walled city with its typical white houses, narrow streets and a medieval environment. Free time to visit the city. **Nazaré**: One of the most typical fishing villages in Portugal. Free time. **Batalha**: 14th Century Monastery, representative the Portuguese Gothic style and World Heritage. Visit to the church. **Fátima**: Pilgrimage center known worldwide and where the apparitions of the Virgin Mary took place in 1917. **Lunch**. **Sanctuary**: Free time to visit the Sanctuary and attend the mass. **Aljustrel**: Visit of the houses where the three shepherds that witnessed the apparitions where born, Lúcia, Francisco y Jacinta. Return to Lisbon at the end of the day.



### Day 5 • Lisbon / Oporto

After breakfast at the hotel, private transfer to Orient Railway station to catch the train Alfa Pendular (2<sup>nd</sup> Class) to Oporto 2 hours and 30 minutes. Upon arrival to Oporto Campanhã Station, meet & assist from our representatives and transfer to the Hotel Fénix Porto 4\* or similar. Accommodation at the hotel.

### Day 6 • Oporto

Buffet breakfast at the hotel and departure for Half-Day Tour to the city of Oporto – the Northern Capital of Portugal, World Heritage, and proud owner of an incredible Historical City center, elected as the Best Touristic Destination in the world in 2013 by *Lonely Planet*. From its Cathedral to the Oporto Wine Cellars, everything in this wonderful city contributes for a memorable trip, filled with memories and environments rich in history, tradition and culture.

### Day 7 • Oporto / Braga / Guimarães / Oporto

Buffet breakfast at the hotel and beginning our Full Day Tour with Lunch to the cities of Braga and Guimarães. An unique route, beginning in Braga, one of the oldest religious cities in the World, with its Sanctuaries that make up the “Triangle of Faith”: Cathedral, Sameiro Sanctuary and Bom Jesus Sanctuary. In the afternoon, after lunch, we'll follow to Guimarães – Cradle City of Portugal and first Capital of the country. Visit to its Castle and most significant palaces. Return to Oporto at the end of the day.

### Day 8 • Oporto

Breakfast at the hotel followed by transfer to Oporto Airport to board the flight back home.
